Guidelines for IUBMB - FEBS Education Conference Bursaries

A certain number of bursaries are available for young scientists to enable participation in the FEBS-IUBMB Education Conference in Rehovot. These grants cover the registration fee, and support travel and accommodation costs up to a maximum of 500 Euros.

The candidates will be selected on merit, subject to the eligibility criteria below. The applicants should send their complete applications (see below) together with documented proof of their eligibility and a recommendation letter from the current or previous supervisor to Prof. Anat Yarden at iris.mazor@weizmann.ac.il

The deadline for submitting an application is May 1, 2017.

Eligibility criteria

- The applicant should be registered as a PhD student or post-doctoral scientist at an institute of higher learning in an IUBMB member country (FEBS members are also members of IUBMB);
- The applicant must be a member of IUBMB (FEBS members are also members of IUBMB);
- The applicant cannot be a resident of the country hosting the event (i.e., Israel);
- The applicant must have at least two years and at most seven years of education experience;
- Only travel from the applicant's current country of residence to Israel is supported;
- Preference will be given to eligible applicants who have not received support from IUBMB or FEBS to attend a similar event the year before.

Information to include in application

- Current or previous supervisor's (head of department's) letter (if applicable) or equivalent, giving information on the educational experience of the candidate;
- Maximum one side of A4 listing reasons for application for bursary, including details about education experience;
- A proof of acceptance of a poster or workshop abstract to the conference;
- Proof of membership in an IUBMB / FEBS Constituent Society;
- Proof of country of residence;
- Details of previous grants received from IUBMB and from FEBS.
