

## Conference Poster proposals

The conference posters will provide participants an opportunity to present their work on teaching and learning of biochemistry and molecular biology (and related molecular life sciences) and can be either finished projects or projects in progress. Posters will be available for viewing during a dedicated interactive poster sessions where authors can discuss their poster with other delegates and will enable informal discussion and feedback.

Poster submissions will be evidence-based and should outline the background / context and outcomes.

Proposals should include the following information:

An abstract (maximum 400 words) must be submitted for review. The abstract should include the title and describe

1. Background / context
2. Research / initiative/practice
3. Methodology and analysis / evaluation method
4. Outcomes and effectiveness

The presenters need to complete their registration formalities before acceptance for poster presentation can be delivered from the organisers. If the presenter has also applied for the Young Scientist bursary (with an abstract, as well), then according to the results of the Bursary evaluation, he / she will be informed of the steps to take.
